Welcome to Sound Mind School of Music! Please read the following as some changes are being made to the rates and scheduling at Sound Mind:

Starting September 1st, 2021 students will now have the option of paying for monthly lessons at the beginning of each month for a reduced rate or students may pay for each lesson as they are scheduled. Below are the new rates:

Paid monthly:

1 hour lesson - \$90
30 minute lesson - \$60

Paid per lesson:

1 hour lesson - \$100
30 minute lesson - \$75

Cancellation/Rescheduling Policy:

We have a very busy schedule of lessons and it is really important to adhere to the times agreed upon out of respect for both educators and other students. You must give at least 24 hours notice if you are unable to attend a lesson or you forfeit the fee paid. If you are late or otherwise need to shift the time, then your lesson may be cut short or cancelled and you must still pay the full fee. We know scheduling and timing can be difficult, but in order for the school to maintain consistency, it is really important that we establish this and appreciate your understanding.

Recording a demo:

At Sound Mind, you have the unique opportunity to have a professional recording of your voice, instrument, or composition produced in-house. This can range from making a cover of your favorite song to recording an original song or composition. Your song will be produced, engineered, mixed and mastered and you will have the opportunity to share your work with the world!

Following are the fees for the different services offered:

- Voice/Inst. recording, engineering and mixing: \$200
- Voice/Inst. production, recording, engineering and mixing: \$400
- Voice/Inst. production, recording, engineering, mixing, mastering: \$550
